Phrasal Verbs

Phrasal Verb: A phrasal verb = verb + preposition (or adverb) → together, they make a new meaning

Example:

- **Go out**
- **Turn out**
- **Get up**
- **Look after**
- **Get along**
- **Go away**
- **Work out**
- **Break up**

_ Steve and Anna ***grew up*** in the same town.

_ Anna ***went away*** to college.

_ Things didn't ***work out***, so they decided to break up.

Relative Clauses

Relative Clauses: They begin with who, that, and which. They give information about people or things.

1. **Who** = used for people
2. **Which** = used for things
3. **That** = used for people and things
